PROJECT PADAVIYA

Here is the latest progress update on our ongoing initiative aimed at building capacity in remote areas. Our dedicated efforts in Padaviya have yielded remarkable results. With a clear focus on empowering the local community to cultivate and market their own "Scotch Bonnet" (Nai Miris) produce, we have been striving to establish a sustainable source of income for the region. However, we have encountered a significant challenge in the form of recurrent wild elephant intrusions, posing a considerable threat to the harvest.

In response to this pressing issue, we have initiated the construction of an electric fence surrounding the property, aiming to ensure the protection of the plantation. The project's development is now underway, and we are pleased to inform you that LLG is diligently overseeing both the financial aspects and the overall progression of the initiative.









We are happy to introduce another new project we have taken on which focuses on the St. Joseph's sewing centre situated in Moratuwa, Sri Lanka. Under the management of a dedicated nun, the centre has been diligently engaged in tailoring and exporting church cassocks to international markets. However, in our ongoing efforts to ensure sustainability and growth, this project marks a unique approach.

LLG has undertaken the pivotal role of providing business consultancy services to analyse the operations of the centre and transform it into a more robust and profitable source of income for the church. As we embark on this transformative journey, we are actively seeking the assistance of business experts who are willing to volunteer their expertise and time to contribute to the advancement of this small business. We are in need of individuals who can thoroughly analyse the existing business model, identify potential weaknesses, and provide strategic consultancy on enhancing its profitability and overall efficiency.



PROJECT NAGODA

We are excited to introduce you to a new project we have taken over. Project Nagoda, an initiative that aims to foster agricultural development within the Nagoda premises. Our strategic focus involves the cultivation of two specific crops: "Ambung" and "Kolikottu Banana" and "Capsicum".
