PROVIDING AID AND RELIEF

To identify immediate needs of the less fortunate members of society, the orphaned and the homeless youth, women and children and contribute towards improving their way of life.



CAPACITY BUILDING

To encourage and provide resources for the self-sustainability of the less fortunate communities.



EDUCATION, AND TRAINING

Produce training and education programmes that will aid in the self-employment of the unemployed individuals of our community. We are proud to share some of our recent initiatives:

The overall problem faced by many underprivileged communities in Sri Lanka is poverty and lack of access to basic needs and opportunities. This has made a profound impact on the quality of life, economic development, inadequate infrastructure, and long-term development and sustainability.

PROJECT PADAVIYA

As a charity organization, we recognize the challenges faced by the Padaviya community. In our initial stage of providing immediate **aid and relief**, we focused on providing essential school supplies to young students, ensuring that they have the resources to succeed in their studies. In our second stage, we have taken a comprehensive approach to **build capacity** and to create a sustainable solution that addresses the unique needs of the region. Our greenhouse project will provide the community with the resources and support needed to grow and sell their own scotch bonnet produce, creating a new source of income and breaking the cycle of poverty. With this project, we aim to empower the community to improve their own lives and build a brighter future for generations to come.



PROJECT KOKKILAI

We are currently helping the community of Kokkilai in Sri Lanka by addressing their urgent needs and providing **aid and relief** towards it. The school in Kokkilai is facing a shortage of teachers, particularly in mathematics, which is having a significant impact on the education of the students. To tackle this issue, we are funding the salary of a mathematics teacher for one year, ensuring that the students have access to proper teaching and guidance in this crucial subject. Additionally, the community also faces a significant challenge in the form of limited access to clean water. To address this issue, we donated a water purification filter that was installed in the school premises, providing access to clean drinking water for the students and staff.

Our goal is not only to provide immediate relief but also to ensure long-term sustainability for the Kokkilai community by **capacity building**. To achieve this, we conducted a comprehensive analysis of the community and identified a need for practical skills training and job opportunities for the students. Thus, in order to provide **education and training** in this regard, we have decided to fund the resources needed for students to learn how to sew and produce garments, providing them with a valuable skill and source of income. By giving the students a reason to attend school and practical skills to support themselves and their families, we aim to build a brighter future for the Kokkilai community.

PROJECT RELIEF

The recent challenges in Sri Lanka have caused significant hardships, leaving many individuals and families struggling to meet basic needs, including food. As a charity organization, we are working with St. Anthony's Church to provide weekly lunch packs to the homeless community, serving over 4000 meals so far. While this **provides immediate relief**, we are also collaborating with other churches in Colombo to establish a weekly soup kitchen for school children, providing nutritious meals on a regular basis. This sustainable initiative addresses the root causes of poverty and food insecurity, helping those in need grow, learn, and thrive. Our organization is committed to making a lasting difference in the lives of the Sri Lankan people.



WHAT'S COMING UP

LLG has partnered with the St. Joseph's Sewing Centre situated in Moratuwa, Sri Lanka, to uncover sustainable export prospects. Under the leadership of the talented Sr. Victorine, this centre is specialized in tailoring cassocks and robes for priests. However, they have faced challenges in turning a profit. LLG has taken the reins by diving deep into their current business model, identifying weak spots and providing consultancy on how to build a financially stable enterprise. Our team is tirelessly working towards identifying new export avenues, and we're excited to share our analysis with you soon. Stay tuned for our upcoming projects, as we strive to create a sustainable future for this centre and its artisans.
